Frequently Asked Questions

Are the requirements associated to the data that are found in the related section within the standard or as footnotes of a table listed in *P2S*?

All of the related footnotes from data tables within standards (e.g., chemical composition, mechanical properties, etc.) are listed as Notes in *P2S*. Many of the specification details from related paragraphs within the standards are also included to support the data in *P2S*. However, there are occasions when the supporting details to data are very complex (e.g., where equations, other tables and further technical requirements are referenced). In these cases, the Note within *P2S* will simply state to “see the standard for more details”. All reasonable efforts are made to include as much information and direction for the user.

When standards are withdrawn or replaced, does *P2S* identify these standards?

Yes. All withdrawn standards are identified and their withdrawn dates are also included if available. If a standard has been withdrawn and replaced, the new replaced standard is given and all its data is included in *P2S*.

Does *P2S* include proprietary data?

No. *P2S* includes data from standard developing organizations (SDOs) such as ASTM, DIN, JIS, etc. and does not include proprietary or company specific data.
