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FOREWORD

Spectrophotometry has become an important tool of the analytical chemist. The information on spectrophotometric methods which have been developed for the determination of various metallic ions is scattered through the literature, and in order to make this information more readily available, the authors have selected references from two leading analytical journals and arranged them according to the metal to be determined. It is hoped that this will provide the analytical chemist with the information he needs without the necessity of a tedious search through the literature.

This bibliography covers the Analytical Edition of *Industrial and Engineering Chemistry*, Vol. 1 through *Analytical Chemistry*, Vol. 23, No. 10 (1951) and *The Analyst*, Vol. 62 through Vol. 76, No. 906 (1951). The references from *Industrial and Engineering Chemistry*, Vol. 1 to 16, No. 6 and *The Analyst*, Vol. 62 to Vol. 69, No. 5 had previously been published in *ASTM Proceedings*, Vol. 44, p. 740 (1944). No attempt has been made by the authors to verify the results, and they have cataloged the references as found. In most cases, where a method involves more than one ion the reference appears under each.
