## FOREWORD

Full scale tests on house structures, though expensive and time consuming, are considered very essential and worthwhile in providing data for economic and adequate design. There are many problems of load application in simulating natural conditions and considerable instrumentation involved in these tests.

Papers and discussions dealing with these problems were presented in a session of the Second Pacific Area National Meeting of the American Society for Testing Materials held in Los Angeles, Calif., September 16-21, 1957.

The symposium was sponsored jointly by Committees D-7 on Wood and E-6 on Methods of Testing Building Constructions. R. F. Legget, National Research Council of Canada, was chairman of the symposium committee and served as chairman of the technical session.
