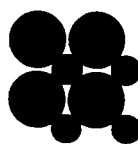

The information contained in this compilation is based on the data supplied by 80 U. S. producers (usually melters) of stainless steels, corrosion and heat resistant castings, and superalloys. This revision also contains powder-metallurgy-produced products.

This document does not include information from processors such as forgers, rerollers, wire drawers, etc., since they are not primary metal producers.
