

### Retraction

Uva JL. Review: Autoerotic Asphyxiation in the United States. *J Forensic Sci* 1995 40(4):574–581.

The journal herewith retracts Tables 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the above-referenced review article, along with all portions of the text that are solely dependent on those tables. The tables were inadvertently published without clear and unequivocal indication that they had appeared in the previously published sources cited as references. It is further noted that Table 5 of the above-referenced review article contains a significant error: the third table heading

should read “Body position,” not “Initial body position,” and the ninth table heading should read “Initial Assessment,” not “Assessment.” Interested readers should consult Byard RW, Hucker SJ, Hazelwood RR.
