F O R E W O R D

One of the major activities of ASTM Committee D-12 on Soaps and Other Detergents is to engage in the background study and research that is often a necessary preliminary for developing good test methods and specifications. This bibliography of articles on primary soil deposition and soil accumulation is part of a continuing effort in Committee D-12 to arrive at meaningful realistic methods for evaluating detergency. Although they might well be of concern to various other ASTM committees, any test methods or specifications on soilability as such would probably be outside the scope of Committee D-12. Nevertheless, detergency or soil removal is the inverse of soil accumulation in more than the simple semantic sense, and it is hoped that the material herein covered will help in attaining the primary goal.
