Our service partners follow the policies and procedures of the ASTM Committee on Publications (COP) under the guidance of the ASTM publications staff.

Peer Review for Books and Journals

Wiley Publishing Services, which was previously J&J Editorial, handles the peer review process for ASTM's books and journals. They have more than a decade of operational and management experience and have developed a strategically focused organization dedicated to efficient and professional management of the peer review editorial office.

Wiley Publishing Services uses sophisticated databases that track all stages of the paper, from submission to acceptance. Their administrative staff routes papers or book chapters to the appropriate journal or book editor. Those editors select appropriate reviewers and make all final judgments regarding the acceptability of the paper or book chapter. The Wiley Publishing Services staff does not make any decisions regarding the quality of the submitted papers or the book chapters.

Journal Production

In addition to handling the peer review process for books and journals, Wiley Publishing Services also handles the production for ASTM's journals. This includes copyediting, typesetting, sending proofs to authors and/or editors, querying authors as needed, implementing author and editor corrections, digitizing content and creating metadata, and providing printer files to ASTM for applicable products.

Wiley Publishing Services sends proofs to authors and/or editors and works with them to ensure all corrections are implemented. Authors or editors approve all journal articles before Wiley Publishing Services sends them to ASTM for publication.

Book Production

KnowledgeWorks Global Ltd. (KGL) is one of our service partners. They handle the production for ASTM's books, including Selected Technical Papers (STPs), Manuals, Monographs, Data Series, and Technical Reports. This includes copyediting, typesetting, sending proofs to authors and/or editors, querying authors as needed, implementing author and editor corrections, digitizing content and creating metadata, and providing printer files to ASTM for applicable products.

The KGL Project Manager sends two sets of proofs to book authors: the first is the copyedited Word file, and the second is the typeset page proof. Authors or editors approve all book chapters before KGL sends them to ASTM for publication.
