

# ASTM Terms of Use

## ASTM Insight SQC

(Version 2026.03.01)

### **IMPORTANT – READ THESE TERMS CAREFULLY BEFORE ACCESSING THIS ASTM PRODUCT**

These Terms of Use (“**Terms**”) govern access to and use of the ASTM Product by an Authorized User. These Terms are incorporated into and form part of the ASTM License Agreement for ASTM Insight SQC (the “**Agreement**”) between ASTM International (“**ASTM**”) and the Licensee.

Capitalized terms not defined in these Terms have the meanings set forth in the Agreement. If you are entering into or accepting the Agreement on your own behalf, references to “Licensee” in these Terms include you.

By creating an account, accessing, or using the ASTM Product, you acknowledge and agree that:

- (a) you are an Authorized User under a valid Agreement;
- (b) if you are accessing the ASTM Product on behalf of a Licensee, you have authority to do so; and
- (c) you agree to comply with these Terms and the Agreement.

If you are the Licensee, you acknowledge that you are acting in both capacities as Licensee and Authorized User. If you do not agree, you may not access or use the ASTM Product.

- 1. Relationship to the Agreement.** Your access to and use of the ASTM Product is governed primarily by the Agreement. Nothing in these Terms expands, limits, or modifies the rights or restrictions set forth in the Agreement. In the event of any conflict of these Terms and any other governing document relating to the ASTM Product, the Order of Precedence provision set forth in the Agreement shall control and determine the governing document.

**The Agreement contains additional provisions governing ownership rights, term and termination, indemnification, limitation of liability, and other material terms applicable to the ASTM Product.**

- 2. Authorized User Responsibilities.** Access to the ASTM Product is limited to individuals registered as Authorized Users under a valid Subscription Term and licensed Laboratory location. Accounts are personal, issued on a named-user basis, and may not be shared.

As an Authorized User, you agree to:

- Use the ASTM Product solely for the internal laboratory and business purposes of the Licensee and strictly in accordance with the Agreement;
- Input, upload, and manage Licensee Data responsibly and in compliance with applicable laws and regulations;
- Ensure that all laboratory data entered into the ASTM Product is accurate to the best of your knowledge;
- Comply with all restrictions and limitations set forth in the Agreement;
- Maintain the confidentiality and security of your login credentials; and
- Promptly report any suspected unauthorized access or misuse.

You may not attempt to gain unauthorized access to the ASTM Product, other accounts, or related systems, nor may you circumvent technical access controls, security measures, or usage limitations.

The Licensee remains responsible for access to and use of the ASTM Product under its account, and your actions may be attributed to the Licensee under the Agreement, including where you are the Licensee.

- 3. Prohibited Uses.** Any use of the ASTM Product, Content, or Derived Outputs beyond what is expressly permitted in the Agreement is prohibited.

Without limitation, you may not:

- Provide any third party with access to the ASTM Product or allow use outside the licensed Laboratory or Subscription Term;
- Reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, or attempt to derive source code, algorithms, or underlying methodologies;
- Use the ASTM Product to develop, benchmark, validate, train, or enhance any competing product or service;
- Circumvent per-Laboratory licensing restrictions or named-user limitations;
- Introduce malicious code, scripts, or harmful data into the ASTM Product;
- Use the ASTM Product, ASTM Tools, or any intellectual property of ASTM or its licensors represented in the ASTM Product or incorporated into the Outputs to develop, train, validate, or enhance any artificial intelligence or machine learning system in a manner that extracts, derives, reverse engineers, or replicates such intellectual property;
- Interfere with or disrupt the operation, integrity, or performance of the ASTM Product.

Nothing in this Section prohibits Licensee from using Outputs to the extent based on Licensee Data for internal business purposes, including internal analytics or artificial intelligence or machine learning systems, provided that such use does not involve the extraction, derivation, reverse engineering, or replication of any intellectual property of ASTM or its licensors embodied in the ASTM Product or incorporated into the Outputs.

These restrictions are in addition to, and do not limit, the restrictions set forth in the Agreement.

#### **4. Regulatory and Decision-Support Disclaimer.**

ASTM Insight SQC is a statistical quality control and decision-support tool. It assists laboratories in organizing data, generating analyses, and preparing regulatory-support documentation.

ASTM does not guarantee regulatory compliance, accreditation outcomes, or audit results. The responsibility for compliance with applicable laws, regulations (including without limitation 40 CFR 1090), accreditation requirements, and internal quality systems remains solely with the Licensee and its Authorized Users.

#### **5. Account Security and Monitoring.**

You must promptly notify ASTM and, if applicable, the Licensee administrator of any known or suspected unauthorized use of your account or breach of security.

ASTM may monitor use of the ASTM Product to verify compliance with the Agreement and these Terms, maintain security, and support operation of the ASTM Product, subject to the Agreement.

ASTM may suspend or disable an Authorized User account if it reasonably believes the account is being used in violation of the Agreement or these Terms.

#### **6. Suspension and Termination of Access.** Access to the ASTM Product may be suspended or terminated if:

- The Licensee's Subscription Term expires or is not renewed;
- ASTM determines that you have violated the Agreement or these Terms; or
- Your use of the ASTM Product poses a security, legal, or operational risk.

Upon suspension or termination, you must immediately cease all access to and use of the ASTM Product.

#### **7. Updates to These Terms.** ASTM may update these Terms from time to time. Updated Terms may be presented within the ASTM Product for review and affirmative acceptance. Continued access to the ASTM Product following presentation of updated Terms requires acceptance of the updated Terms.
